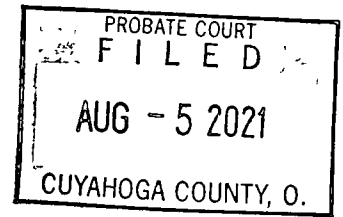

**JUDGMENT ENTRY**

The administrative orders dated March 16 and May 21, 2020, June 10 and June 25, 2021 issued in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis are amended as follows:

The Probate Division of Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas makes the following Findings of Fact:

1. On July 31, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention identified Ohio and Cuyahoga County as an area of "substantial transmissions". Recent evidence suggests that the Delta variant of COVID-19 is highly transmissible. Further studies show that while the vaccine is effective and reduces the risk of sever COVID-19 symptoms, even those who are vaccinated can spread the highly contagious Delta variant.
2. The CDC and Cuyahoga County Board of Health updated their guidance recommending that those in areas of substantial transmission, including those who are fully vaccinated, wear a face covering in public indoor settings.
3. In the continuing effort to protect the health and safety of our employees and the public we serve:

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

1. Effective August 5, 2021, all visitors and employees entering the Old Courthouse will be required to wear a mask covering both their nose and mouth. ~~This shall include~~ areas accessible to the public; common areas; any area where you meet or assisting the public; and when a workspace is in a common area and there is no ability to social distance.
2. All prior orders and health screening protocols not in conflict shall remain in effect.
